By connecting teachers from different countries with Zambian teachers through learning visits, we hope to raise the profile of rural Zambian schools and promote intercultural learning between teachers for personal and professional growth.

LEARNING FOCUS AREAS:

1

Promoting play-based learning in early years

Working with teachers to promote play-based learning in the early years (children aged 3-7) and move away from traditional rote-teaching.

2

Strengthening English reading instruction

Working with teachers to strengthen English language teaching and learning (children aged 8-14), to set students up for success in later years.

3

Building classroom community and resilience

Working with teachers on how to effectively build community among students (all ages) to ensure classrooms are a safe and happy place.

4

School management and coaching

Working with head-teachers, teacher supervisors and school managers to strengthen professional development of teachers through data-driven decision making and coaching approach to professional development.
